Kia ora Kerry

Here is our latest understanding of the timeframes for various deliverables and meetings in the few days:

- **Thursday 24 March**
  - Draft 'Report Back' Cabinet paper for Ministerial review (*we had intended to get this to advisers earlier this week, although this has not been possible due to constraints on resourcing and the ongoing discussions with Auckland Council regarding the Heads of Terms*) We intend to launch departmental consultation at a similar time, and we will need Ministerial feedback by midday Wednesday 30 March in order to commence Ministerial consultation on either 31<sup>st</sup> March or 1 April.
- **Monday 28 March**
  - Final ALR Board interview
  - Interview panel wrap-up

NOTE – after the interviews and concurrently with the wrap up session, Officials will need to be (1) writing a summary of the last interview on Monday, (2) finishing the substantive briefing and (3) providing input into the Aide Memoire

When ready, and to inform Ministers' meeting on Monday evening, Officials will provide:

- **A briefing** with recommended ALR Board members
- **An aide memoire** covering:
  - A summary of Board appointment recommendations as reflected in the briefing – **for decision**
  - An updated approach to ALR Board fees (including an updated letter for Minister of Public Services to be signed by the Minister of Transport) – **for decision**
  - A refined approach to identifying mana whenua representation at Sponsor level (following further work by Officials) – **for agreement/direction**
- **Wednesday 30 March**
  - Feedback needed from Ministers on the Report Back Cabinet paper
- **Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> / Friday 1<sup>st</sup>**
  - APH paper for Ministerial consultation
  - Report back Cabinet paper for Ministerial Consultation
